What is IELTS?

IELTS is an internationally recognized English proficiency examination used widely by universities, employers, and immigration authorities to assess a candidate's ability to communicate fluently and effectively in English. Depending on your personal goals, you must choose between two major types of exams:

IELTS Academic

Specific and tailored for students applying to higher education institutions, undergraduate programs, or postgraduate degrees abroad.

For study abroad applications, most students will require this test version.

IELTS General Training

Primarily geared toward migration, visa validation, structural work placement requirements, and general non-academic training purposes.

IELTS Test Structure

The exam thoroughly screens your core linguistic abilities and is divided into four distinct sections. Total testing time spans approximately 2 hours and 45 minutes.

Listening Duration: 30 Minutes | 40 Questions

Tests your capability to comprehend spoken English contextually across a range of different international accents, dialogues, and monologues.

Reading Duration: 60 Minutes | 3 Passages

Assesses multi-layered comprehension, structural reading speed, argument scanning, and advanced vocabulary understanding.

Writing Duration: 60 Minutes | 2 Tasks

Task 1 (20 mins): Formulating a data report or visual description based on charts, graphs, or maps.

Task 2 (40 mins): Executing a formal, discursive essay responding to a specific point of view or argument.

Speaking Duration: 11–14 Minutes | 3 Parts

Conducted live as a face-to-face interactive interview with an official examiner to evaluate real-time conversational competency.

IELTS Band Scores & University Standards

IELTS performance scores range linearly from Band 1 (Non-User) up to Band 9 (Expert User). Universities typically look at overall scores along with minimum threshold bands across individual skills.

Band Score	Skill Level Description	Typical University Benchmarks
9.0	Expert User	Highly competitive courses (e.g., Medicine, Law, advanced Research degrees) often look for scores in this elite tier.
8.0	Very Good User	
7.0	Good User	Standard benchmark target for elite institutions and competitive Postgraduate Programmes (typical range: 6.5 – 7.5).
6.0	Competent User	Standard baseline requirement for entry into most Undergraduate Programmes (typical range: 6.0 – 6.5).

- A certified **Medium of Instruction (MOI)** document provided by your former university.
- Proof that your entire previous educational curriculum was instructed 100% in English.
